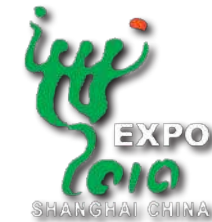




company in brief

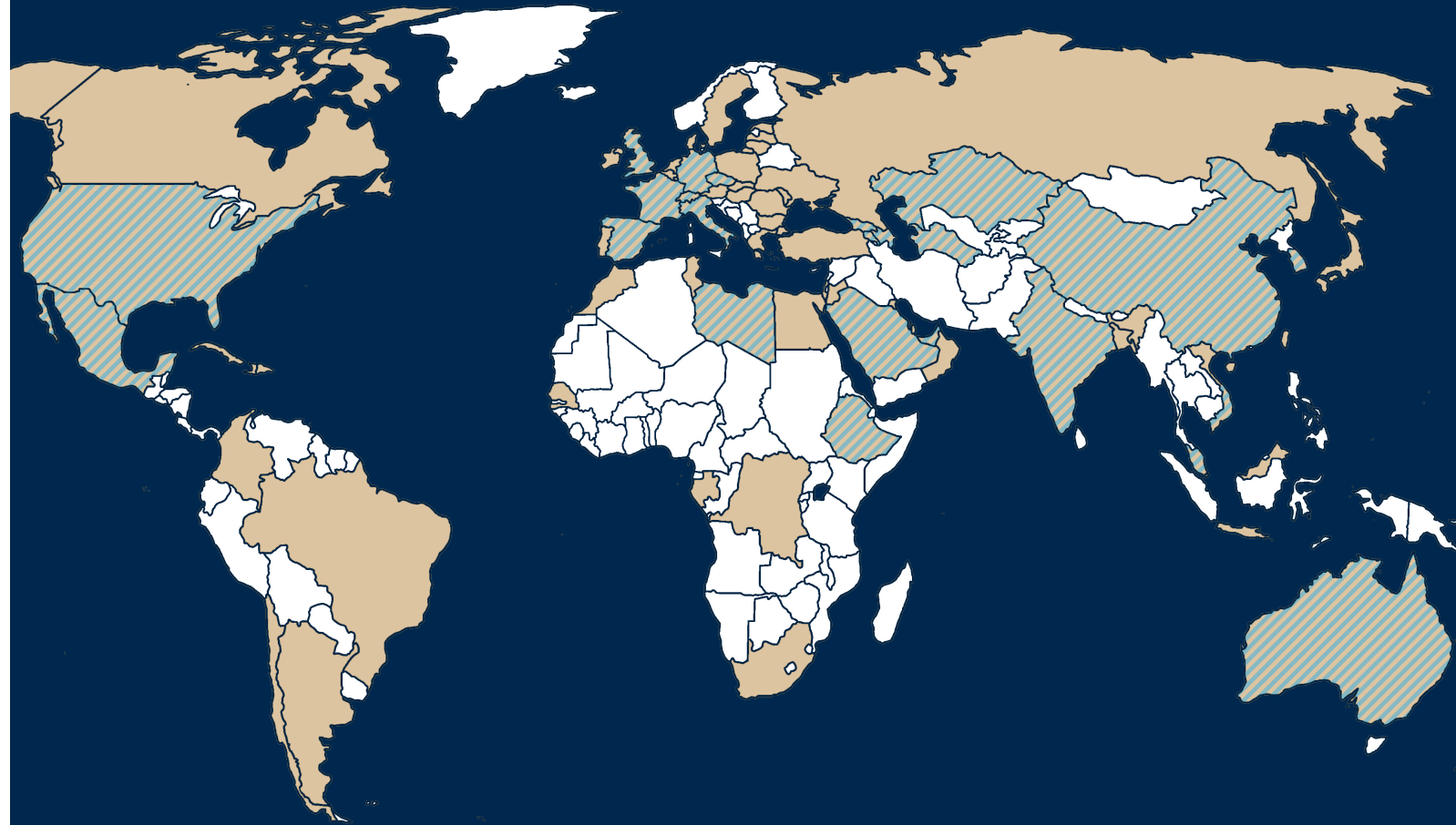

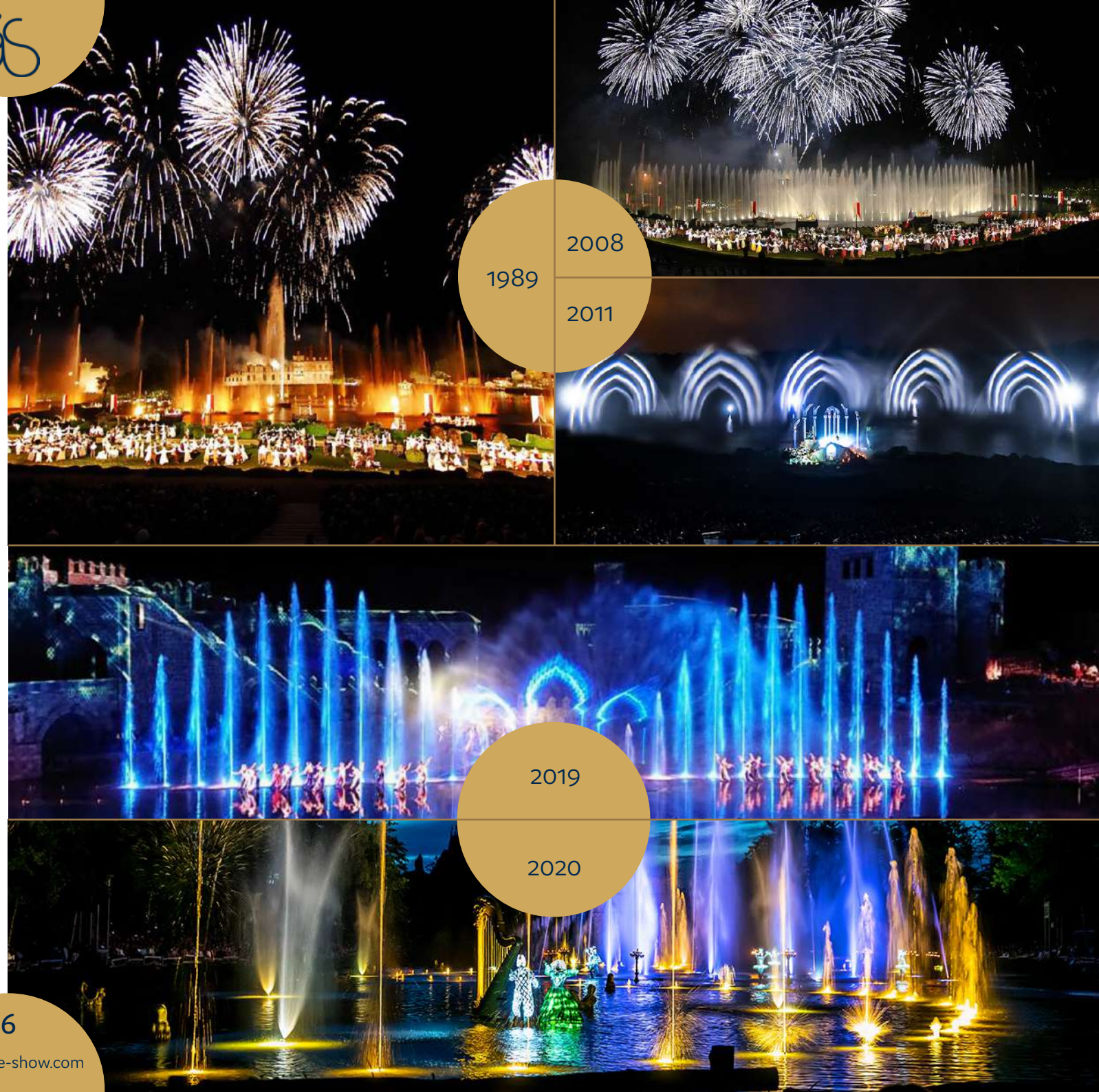

The Park of the Puy du fou is a good example of our long term collaborations based on constant innovation and reliability.

The Puy du Fou entrusted us to integrate a fountain to their major show « La Cinéscénie » in 1989. This fountain equipment was already playing for almost 30 years when the Park decided to upgrade the show with some of our new water effects and lights in 2008 & 2011.

In 2019, the Puy du Fou exported its concept of historical park in Spain and so was born the Puy du fou Toledo in which we integrated a permanent water show.

In 2020, we upgraded the fountain and water effects for a new permanent show « Les Noces de Feu ».

Dominique FORMHALS Founder & CEO

Dominique Formhals was born on March 11, 1955 in Strasbourg son of Jean Formhals (1915-2004) teacher and Fernande born Ehrhardt (1929-1998) teacher.

Studies at Lycée Fustel de Coulanges in Strasbourg - Baccalaureate - then Law school of Strasbourg (2 years) before entering working life.

Jean and Dominique Formhals created « Les Orgues Aquatiques de Strasbourg » in 1973 and presented their first water shows in Alsace.

In 1979, at the age of 24, Dominique Formhals created the company Aquatique Show which he has managed since.

Dominique Formhals was honored with the Fondation Alsace Honor Prize in 2000,

the Entrepreneur of the Year Prize (L'Entreprise / Ernst & Young) in 2005,

the Export Trophy of the newspaper les Echos in 2007,

and the Bretzel d'Or in 2010.

Dominique Formhals is also the president of the Maison de l'Alsace in Paris.

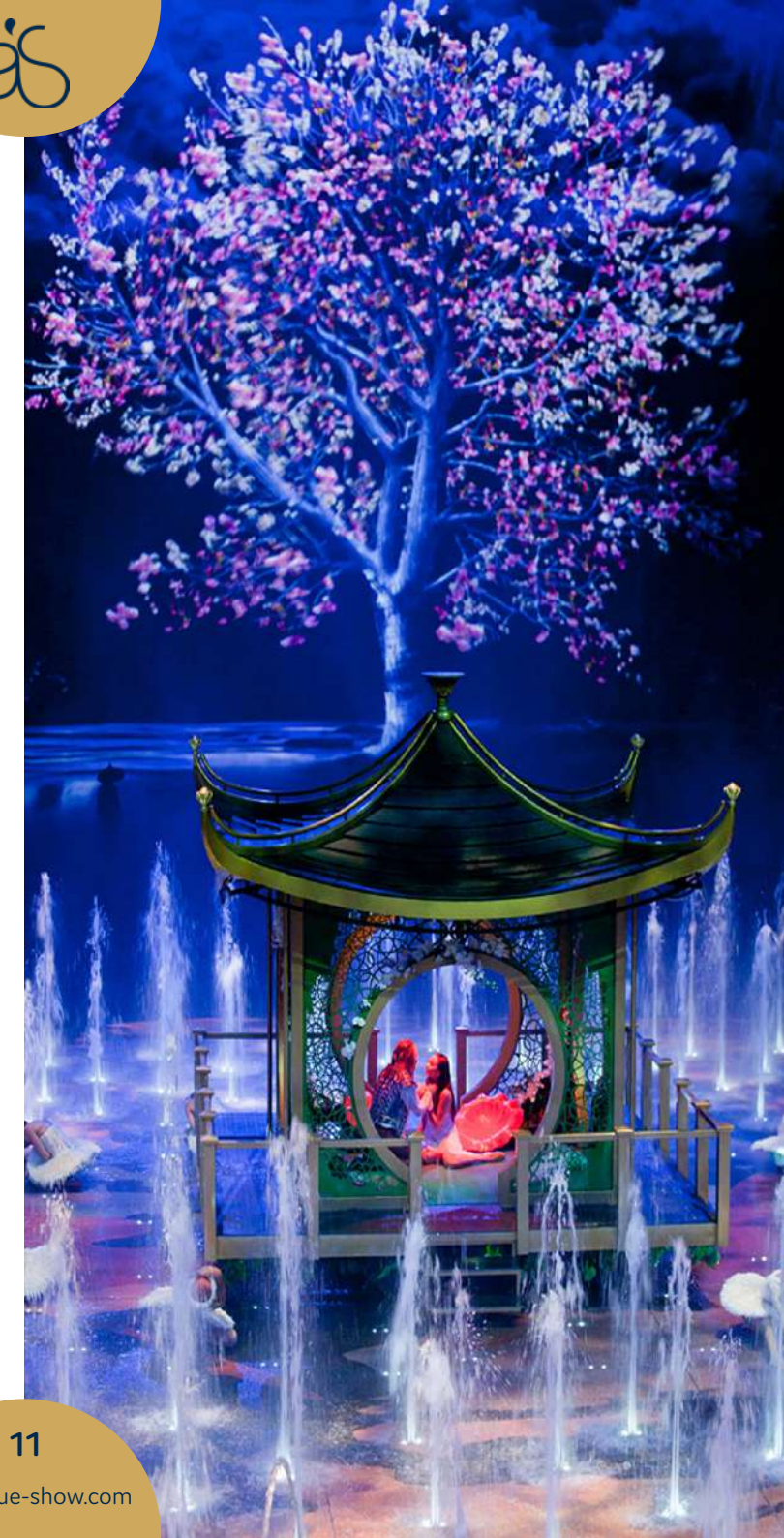

chronology in brief

1979

Creation of the company by Dominique Formhals, its current CEO.

1979
to 1988

Aquatique Show presents its Musical Fountains (2 to 5 shows per week) throughout France and neighboring European countries (Belgium, Switzerland, Germany).

1988

Development of the first water curtain for high quality video projection. First installation of this curtain at the Lido de Paris, France.

1991

Development of the first water screen for giant projections in Disney and Seaworld parks, USA.

1998

Aquatique Show becomes the leading supplier of water effects and shows in the Middle East.

2000

Development of the first pneumatic Moving Jet, and his first installation at the Universal Exhibition in Hannover, Germany.

2001

Creation of the AquaGraphic water curtain, which can accommodate high quality projection, and allows you to cut shapes and texts directly into the water surface.



chronology in brief

2001
to 2004

Aquatique Show is developing many projects in Asia: permanent shows in Ningbo & Nanjing, temporary shows in Singapore and Hong Kong for the Shopping Festival.

2004

Aquatique Show is developing a new type of fountains for Europa Park, Germany: the Tornado fountain is a complete water show but also a water playground for children.

2007

Aquatique Show installs the world's largest temporary multimedia water show for Volkswagen in Autostadt, Wolfsburg, Germany. This show will grow with each edition until 2015.

2008

Creation of the electric Moving Jet on 2 axes.
Aquatique Show works with Franco Dragone to build the largest indoor water theater ever created: "the House of Dancing Water" opens at City of Dreams in Macao, China in 2010.

2010

Aquatique Show creates the largest floating water show in the world for the Shanghai World Expo, China.

2011

Aquatique Show Installs two circular Aqua Graphic Water Curtains for Celine Dion's show at Caesars Palace in Las Vegas, which will play 70 performances a year until 2019.

2013

Aquatique Show is developing the Flower jet: a straight jet that opens to form a corolla.
Creation of water effects for the Disney Dreams show at Disney, Paris, France.





chronology in brief

2016

Aquatique Show develops interactive water effects that can be controlled by the public using joysticks or motion sensors.

2017

Design and installation of a permanent water show "Spectra" with a 200 meter façade in Marina Bay, Singapore
Aquatique Show incorporates lava and eruption effects on the Volcano of Volcano Bay, Orlando, USA.

2018

Aquatique Show creates the "Cinematic Celebration" water show for Universal Park in Orlando, USA.

2019

With the East New Town fountain in Ningbo, more than 20 permanent fountains are playing every day in China.

2020

Creation of the water show for "Les noces de Feu" at Puy du Fou, France.

2022

Creation of a set of water shows and effects of more than 6,000m² for the Vidanta Group in Mexico.
